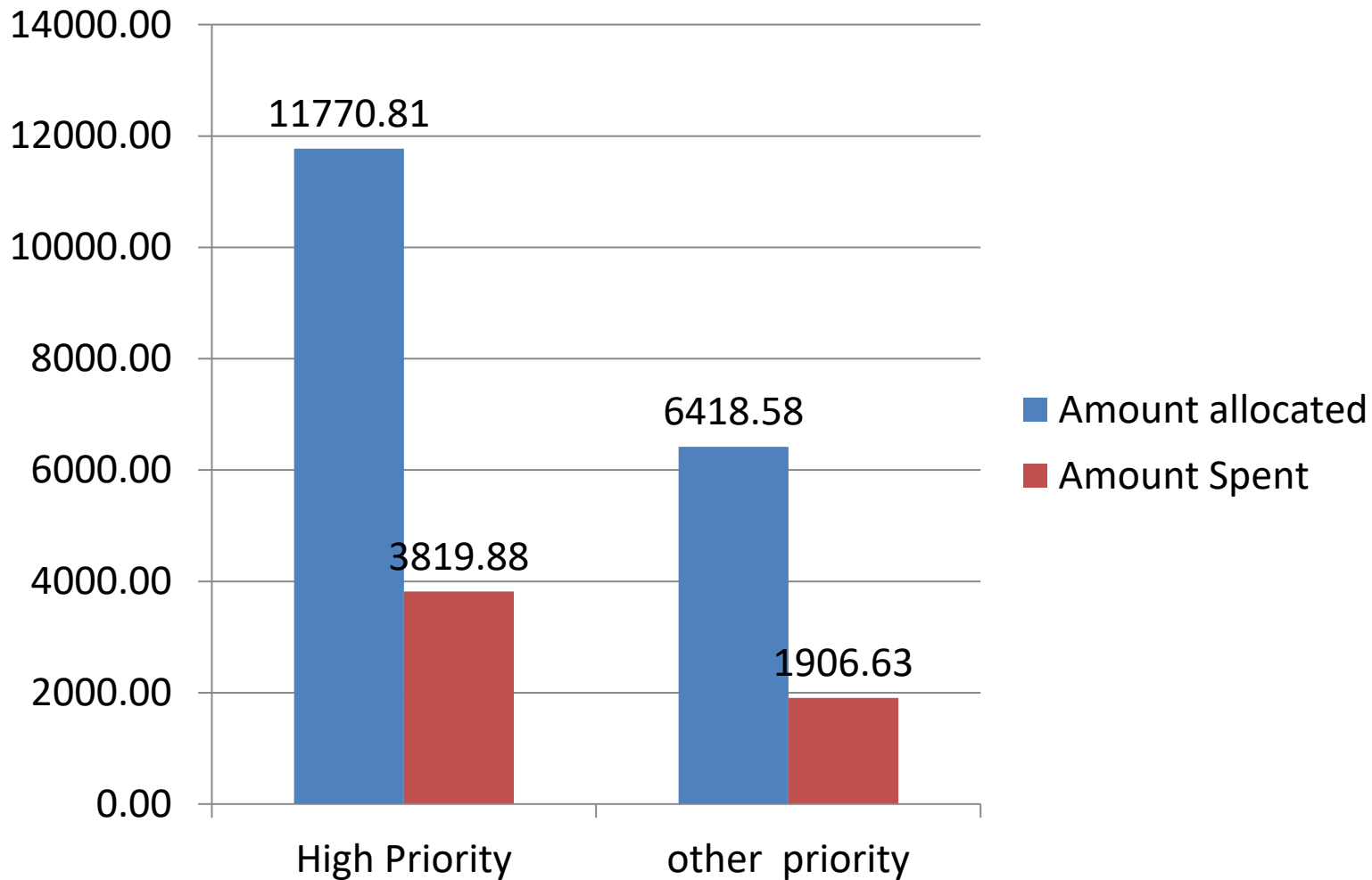

Priority –wise fund allocation & amount spent



1 Should we allow change in proportion

- Present proportion is OK and proposed to be continued
- Core zone affected person and areas to be given top priority
- District level core zone and buffer zone to be defined and reviewed every 2 years

2 Any other sector to be included

- Statewise specific Primary sector may be considered in High priority areas of DMF

3 How to ensure Project Planning in line with targeted socio economics indices of the district

- Long term planning should be mapped and district level guidelines shall be framed in this regard
- Additional technical staff to review the plan and its implementation

4 How to ensure Social Sector get more funding

- This aspects will be covered as per comments in previous slides

5 Ensuring projects undertaken under PMKKKY shall be complimentary to Central and State Projects

- In order to ensure effective utilisation of DMFT funds upto 25 % as decided by District trust

6 Dissemination of Information about Project implementation at Panchayat and district level

- Adequate branding of projects under DMFT fund expenses
- Geo tagging of such major projects
- Evaluation of Schemes at least every 2 years from an independent agency
- Incentives by facilitation for best performing districts in such National Workshop every year
