TENDER NOTICE

**Subject: Invitation of tender quotation for supply of toner cartridges
for use in the Ministry of Mines.**

Ministry of Mines proposes to procure various toner cartridges for computer printers for its day-today office use. The firms interested in supplying the toner cartridges as per the annexure enclosed, may submit their quotations in the Tender Box, Ministry of Mines. The tender form complete in all respect should be sent in sealed cover and super-scribed as **“Quotation for the supply of toner cartridges in the Ministry of Mines.”** The tender box kept at the information & facilitation center, garage No. 23, ground floor, ‘A’ Wing , Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi at the latest by 28th January, 2013 upto 12.00 P.M. The quotations should be accompanied by a Demand Draft of the earnest money of Rs.50,000/-. Quotations received after stipulated date/time and without earnest money shall not be entertained. The quotations will be opened on the same day by ‘Tender Opening Committee’ at 3.00 P.M. in the Ministry in the presence of the tenderers or their representatives who may like to be present.

2. The annual agreement will be governed by the following terms and conditions:-

a) In emergency situations, the firm should be in a position to supply toner cartridges on very short notice.

b) All expenses will be borne by the firm for sending the toner cartridges to this Ministry.

c) In normal circumstances the toner cartridges should be delivered in this Ministry within 2 days from receipt of the job order.

d) The firms must supply its address and telephone Nos. (Office as well as residence) and also mobile phone numbers so as to contact the firm in emergency, if required. The firm should be able to provide toner cartridges on holidays/Sundays also.

e) The firm should have its annual turnover of more than Rs. 50 lakhs.

f) PAN & TIN Nos. must be provided.

g) The firm must be providing such services to at least five Government Ministries/Departments.

h) The firm must be situated in Delhi.

i) The firm will ensure that the toner cartridges supplied to this Ministry are genuine and contains 3D hologram of the manufacturer. The firm will be held responsible in case of deficiency in the quality of the product.

j) The firm will be liable for any damage caused to the printer/equipment by spurious toner cartridge supplied.

k) The rates will remain valid for a period of one year from the date of award of contract.

4. An earnest money of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) has to be deposited in the form of bank draft drawn in favour of PAO(Mines) alongwith the quotations. Successful tenderer will have to deposit security money of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) in the form of fixed deposit from any of the scheduled Banks pledged in favour of PAO(Mines) Ministry of Mines, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi as security money for the period of contract. Security money will be forfeited if the firm fails to adhere to any of the terms and conditions of the tender enquiry.

5. Cutting/overwriting in tenders shall not be accepted and shall be rejected.

6. The Department reserves the right to accept or reject any tender in full or in part without assigning any reason, thereof. The decision of the Ministry in this regard shall be final and binding.
