Sub:- Recovery under subsection (5) of section 21 of Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 of the price of mineral raised without lawful authority.

Sir,

As you are aware, a Committee was constituted by this Department consisting of yourself, Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Representatives of State Pollution Control Board, Forest & Environment Department, PCCF and DDM (Headquarters) of the Directorate of Mines as members for verification on excess production of ore in the mining leases for iron, manganese, chromite, bauxite and limestone during the last 10 years vis-à-vis quantity approved in the Mining Plan/Scheme under Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1968 and statutory clearances issued under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and consent to operate under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1986.

2. During verification, as many as 104 mines were found to have raised ore in excess of the quantity approved by IBM in the mining plan/scheme in some year or years during the period of 10 years. One hundred and ninety eight mines have made excess production over and above the limit approved under the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and/or under the Water and Air Acts referred to above. The list of the erring mines has been endorsed to the respective Departments/agencies for necessary action under the relevant laws administered by them.

3. In the meantime, Accountant General, Odisha in his Note on Illegal Extraction of Iron ore has pointed out that the Putulpali Iron ore mines has exceeded permissible limit of the production of 1.20 lakh MT of Iron ore per annum from the year 2004-05. The lessee has applied only in September 2006 for environment clearance for enhancement of ore production from 1.20 lakh MT per annum to 3.60 lakh MT per annum. The Government of India accorded environment clearance for the enhanced production capacity of 3.60 lakh MT per annum in August 2007. The lessee, however, produced iron ore in excess of the permitted quantity of 3.60 lakh MT per annum during 2007-08 onwards (up to August 2009). Accordingly, the audit has observed that the lessee has unlawfully produced 25.13 lakh MT of iron ore during the period from 2007-08 to 2009-10 (up to August 2009). For the excess quantity produced in violation of the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Accountant General has made the lessee liable to pay Rs. 216.69 cr. towards price of the ore

raised in excess of 21(5) of M&M(D&R) Act, 1957. It has been decided by Steel & Mines Department to raise demand under the aforesaid provision to recover the dues from the aforesaid mines to render compliance to the observation of the Accountant General. However, the lessee in this case has approached the Central Government under section 30 of MM(DR) Act, 1957 challenging the recovery of the price of the mineral so raised in Revision Application No. 22/(17)/2011-RC-1 wherein the Central Government has ordered that pending final decision in the case, no coercive action for recovery of ₹ 216.69 crores may be made and the impugned order may not come in way of issuance of transit passes to the Revisionist. Therefore, the recovery in this particular case has to wait till the disposal of the revision application.

4. Based on the Committee report which carried out verification of last ten years, you are, however, requested to instruct the Deputy Directors of Mines/ Mining Officers in charge of the mining circles to raise demands against all others mines that made production in excess of the approved limit. The approved limit will be the minimum of the quantity approved in the mining plan/scheme, environment clearance or consent to operate under Air and Water Acts. The recovery under section 21(5) of the Act of 1957 of the price of mineral produced in excess may be effected from the erring lessee for which he may be issued 30 days notice and, wherever necessary, heard in person to meet the ends of justice.

5. The Director of Mines shall furnish the price of minerals for the reference period for recovery under section 21(5) of the Act of 1957. The price should be as published by IBM for the State. In case the prices are not published for a mineral for a particular period, the price of the mineral shall be taken as PMV of the mineral indicated in annual 'H' Form series prescribed under MCDR, 1988 or the average annual price at which OMC has sold the mineral or the price of the mineral as maintained by Directorate of Mines for statistical purposes, whichever is higher.

6. The lessee shall also pay simple interest at the rate of 24% per annum on the sum due towards the price u/s 21(5) of the Act of 1957 until payment of such price as required under the provisions of rule 64A of the Mineral Concession Rules, 1960.

7. The power of the State Government to recover the sum under section 21(5) of the Act of 1957 referred to above is exercisable by the Director of Mines, Odisha for the whole State and by the Deputy Director/ Mining Officer in charge of the mining circles in respect of the areas mentioned in col. 3 of this Deptt. Notification No. 15050/SM dtd. 31.12.1993 (copy enclosed).

Sub: Disposal of Revision Application No.22/22/2010-RC1 (Smt. Indrani Patraik, Petitioner Vrs. State of Odisha - Respondent)


In the captioned revision application the petitioner - mine owner has challenged the notice of the State Government dated 25.11.2010 under section 21(5) of the MMOR Act 1957 calling upon her to make payment of the price of the mineral illegally mined and despatched and under the provisions of rule 27(5) of M.C Rules, 1960 to make good or remedy the breach of lease conditions as the case may be within sixty days from the date of receipt of the notice; failing which the mining lease will be determined and the whole of security deposit forfeited.

2. The Govt. of India in their order dated 01.02.2011 has granted interim stay against the said notice and also directed that "no coercive action e.g. stopping transit permit or mining operations or action upon or giving effect to the impugned order or demand raised therein be taken during pendency of the Revision Application or till further orders, which ever is earlier".

3. While the hearing of the case has been completed on 13.08.2011, orders in the case are still reserved. As the violations committed by the mine owner detected by State Vigilance are serious in nature, the Government of India may, in the interest of justice, pass final orders quickly to enable the State Government to take appropriate action as per law.
