Sub: Disposal of staff car & three wheeler in the Ministry of Mines, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.

It is proposed to dispose off one staff car no. DL-10C-0009 and one three wheeler, Registration Number No.DL-1LD-7144 (make 2000 Bajaj) of the Ministry of Mines.

2. Accordingly, sealed tender quotations are invited for the disposal of said vehicle on the terms and conditions mentioned below. Those interested may submit their quotations in the enclosed Performa. The quotations should be dropped in the 'Tender Box' kept at the Information & Facilitation Center, garage No.23, A wing, ground floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi at the latest by **21<sup>st</sup> July, 2017 upto 12.00 noon**. The quotations will be opened on **24<sup>th</sup> July, 2017** by 'Tender Opening Committee' of Ministry of Mines at 3.00 pm. The bidders or their representative (not more than one) may remain present, if they so desire, at the time of opening of quotations. The sealed cover should be prominently subscribed as "QUOTATION FOR PURCHASE OF CONDEMNED VEHICLE". The vehicle will be available for inspection between 03:00 PM to 05:00 PM at Gate No. 2 Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi on any working day.

3. The tender will be governed by the following conditions:-

- i) The bidder is required to pay **Earnest Money of Rs.5,000/- (for staff car) and Rs.2,000/- (for three wheeler) payable by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi.**
- ii) Quotations received without demand draft towards Earnest Money will not be accepted.
- iii) The successful bidder will be required to deposit the bid amount by means of demand draft drawn in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi within five working days of the acceptance of the bid.
- iv) Earnest Money will be forfeited if the successful bidder fails to honor the bid. The Earnest Money of the successful bidder will be released only after transfer of Vehicle Registration in his name. The EMD of unsuccessful bidder will be returned after finalization of tender.
- v) The delivery of the sold vehicle will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status viz. Aadhar card/Voter identity Card/Passport in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.
- vi) The sold vehicle will be removed by the successful bidder from the premises of Shastri Bhawan within five working days at their own expenses after the issue of sale letter by this Ministry.
