Respected Sir I am filing an appeal to the response that I have got from the Ministry of Mines in respect of the Information sought in respect of the following questions. 1 Kindly provide a copy of the Notice of Arbitration sent by the Ras-AI-Khaimah Investment Authority (RAKIA) to the Indian government under the India-UAE BIT. 2 Has the arbitral tribunal been constituted. 3. Also kindly provide the current status of the investor-state arbitration in the aforesaid case. I am attaching here a copy of the reply which I have got from the Ministry. Following are the questions that have been asked. It has been said that the sought information is exempted under Section 8(1)(a) of the RTI Act 2005. Most respectfully I submit: 1. That the Notice of Arbitration by Ras-al Khaimah Investment Authority (RAKIA) is against the Republic of India, and as the claim involves damages to be paid to the foreign investor, taxpayers money is involved. Accordingly, the citizens of this country have a right to know about all the disputes where the Republic of India may be required to pay compensation or damages, the incidence of which ultimately falls on the citizens of India. 2. That by mere publication of the Notice of Arbitration and the Status of the Investor-State Arbitration, no economic interest is being hampered. I, therefore, request you to kindly grant access to the information sought in the larger public interest.


