

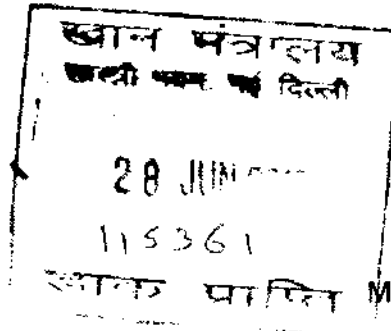

ACTION TAKEN

MINUTE

Subject: Registration of job seekers in the Employment Exchanges having certificates/diplomas from unrecognized institutions/agencies - regarding.

∩ In the NESM, procedure is prescribed for registration of craftsmen/technocrats who obtain diplomas/degrees from government institutes/recognized Institutes but there is no procedure for dealing with job-seekers who possess diplomas /certificates awarded by the unrecognized institutes. Those job-seekers who possess Diplomas /Certificates awarded by unrecognized institutes or Diplomas /Certificates which are not recognised, face difficulties at the time of registration in some Employment Exchanges in the absence of clear instructions in the matter.

This issue was discussed in the 35th meeting of Working Group on NES held at Hyderabad in detail with participation of various representatives of States/UTs. It was found that in States like Tamil Nadu, Kerala and Delhi, such certificates were being accepted at the time of registration without insisting on their recognition, whereas in some other States, the position was different.

Keeping in view the lower placement through Employment Exchanges in Public Sector, increasing attention towards Private Sector and problems faced by the job-seekers at the time of registration at Employment Exchanges, it was recommended by the Working Group that Certificates/Diplomas from unrecognized institutions(except the fake ones) or Diplomas /Certificates which are not recognized may be accepted for registration at Employment Exchanges and the employing agencies/establishments may decide suitability of such jobseekers at the time of recruitment. Thus, onus for verification/ acceptance of Diplomas/Certificates possessed by job-seekers would lie with the employer at the time of their recruitment. This recommendation was also confirmed in the 36th meeting of Working Group on NES held at Thiruvananthapuram on 15th & 16th February, 2010.

Thus, in this respect, instructions given in Chapter VII and Chapter XI of Vol.I of NESM are clarified to the extent that job-seekers who possess Diplomas /Certificates awarded by unrecognized institutes(except fake ones) or Diplomas /Certificates which are not recognized, will not be denied registration on this account, if otherwise found eligible.

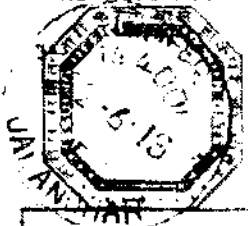

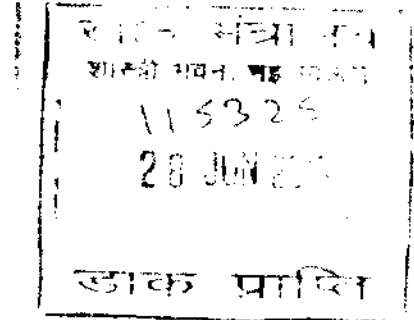
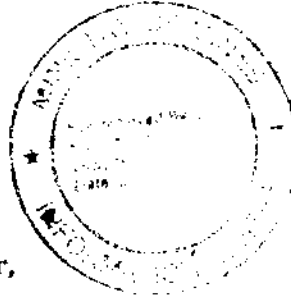

Dear Sir,

Sub: 1. Mines and Minerals – Our Federation has given several Complaints to the Hon'ble Prime Minister, the concerned Secretaries to Govt. of India Such as the Ministry of Mines, the Department of Atomic Energy, the Ministry of Environment and Forest, the Ministry of Finance, etc on some very serious violation committed against the central Acts and Rules by the Illegal and fraudulent Lessees and the officials and also our Federations and its Members have filed 3 Public Interest Litigations vide W.P.(MD) Nos. 5549/2007, 1233/2012 and W.P. No. 1592/2015 in which Ministry of Mines and Indian Bureau of Mines Department of Atomic Energy, Ministry of Environment and Forest are Respondents.

2. The Hon'ble High Court has pass Common Orders on 12.12.2013 in W.P.(MD) Nos. 5549/2007, 1233/2012 and the remaining said one PIL filed in W.P. No. 1592/2015 is now pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras. The Hon'ble High Court has Fixed the final dates of hearing on 7.06.2018 to conduct the pending cases from 9.7.2018 at 2.15 daily till the case is disposed considering the large scale looting of minerals belonging to the government.

3. The Govt. of Tamil Nadu have allowed M/s. V.V. Minerals and their Associates to loot the placer minerals belonging to the Government without valid mining lease and also without valid transport permits in total violation of the relevant Sec. 4.1 and 4.1A of the MM(D&R) Act, 1957 and hence, the 10% cost of the minerals mined and sold shall be recoverable as per Sec. 21 of the said Act and also the Supreme Court Orders.

4. The Supreme Court confirmed violations committed in Iron and Manganese Ore are committed in placer minerals lootings and hence the various Rulings already given by the Supreme Court covering the recovery of the illegally mined minerals, cancellation of illegally granted mining leases, illegally transferred Garnet mining leases and Criminal actions as per Sec.138 of Indian Penal Code etc. covering Iron and Manganese Ore are applicable for placer minerals mining.

5. The Ministry of Mines and the Indian Bureau of Mines Department of Atomic Energy , Ministry of Environment and Forest , Ministry of Finance , etc shall take appropriate actions to recover the 100% cost of the illegally mined and sold minerals, cancellation of illegally granted and transferred mining leases, initiate proper actions as per Se. 138 of IPC ,etc and also seize and dispose illegally stored stocks as per the relevant Acts and Rule Supreme Court Orders in compliance of Article 142 of the Constitution of India by filing proper counters in the pending Suo mottu PIL.- Reg.,

Ref : 1. The Government appointed Special Teams vide G.O.Ms.No. 156 dated 08.08.2013 and 173 dated 17.09.2013, 179 dated 27.07.2015, 29 dated 25.03.2017 and 41 dated 07.04.2017 based on the above said 3 PILs filed by our Federation Members.
2. The Suo-Motu PIL filed in W.P.No. 1592/2015 by Dr. G. Victor Rajamanickam.
3. The Amicus Curiae Comprehensive Report dated 20.06.2017
4. The Chairman of Special Team Mr. Satyabrata Sahoo IAS, submitted report dated 18.04.2018 submitted to the High Court on 24.04.2018.

1. We understand that the Secretary to Government of India, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi has forwarded our complaint letters to the Controller General of Mines/Chief Controller of Mines, IBM, Nagpur and they would have in turn forwarded the same to the Controller of Mines, South Zone, Bangalore to give your reply to them on our representations.

2. The Indian Bureau of Mines and the Ministry of Mines have not filed any proper counters on the various allegations made by us in our said first 2 PILs. The entire 63 Nos. Garnet, etc. mining leases granted to M/s. V.V. Minerals and their Associates without complying the statutory preconditions, as prescribed in the Sec. 4.2 of the said Act are illegal as per the Sec. 19 of the said Act. It is therefore, the entire minerals illegally mined and sold shall be recovered from the concerned companies /lessees.

3. They have illegally operated 50 Nos. Minerals Processing Industries within the National Biosphere of Golf of Manor in Tirunelveli, Kanyakumar and Thoothukudi Districts.

4.1. The Amicus Curiae has submitted his Comprehensive Report dated 20.06.2017 in the pending Suo-Motu PIL in W.P. No. 1592/2015 highlighting all the illegal activities committed by the lessees and also the concerned department officials and also the lessees.

4.2. The Special Team Head Mr. Satyabrata Sahoo, IAS has also submitted his Comprehensive Report to the Hon'ble High court on 24.04.2018 confirming the illegal stock of **1,49,96,223 MTs** of Run of Mines, Processed and Semi Processed Garnet, Ilmenite, Rutile, Zircon, Sillimanite, Leucosene and Monazite and also **Monazite tailings 1,35,135 MTs. The entire storage of minerals are illegal and unlawful.**

5. The above said reports are available with the Indian Bureau of Mines, the Ministry of Mines, the Department of Atomic Energy , the Ministry of Environment and Forest , the Ministry of Finance [Customs and Central Excise Department], etc.

6. The IBM and the AMD is the lawfully authorized Government of India Department to monitor the mining of the minerals, as per the relevant Acts and Rules in India.

7.1. The Supreme Court Order dated 02.08.2017 has also confirmed the same and the relevant portion of the Para 184 is extracted below:

"We make it clear that mineral extracted either without an EC or without an FC or without both would attract the provisions of Section 21(5) of the MMDR Act and 100% of the price of the illegally or unlawfully mined mineral must be compensated by the mining lease holder."

7.2. The AMD and IBM have not taken any proper corrective steps in approval of mining plans and Schemes of Mining but on the other hand, they given bogus reports to their ministries suppressing their various omissions and commissions mentioned in our complaints from 2000 onwards.

7.3. It is pertinent to note that M/s. V.V. Minerals and their Associates have operated the said 63 Nos. of Garnet, etc. mining leases without complying the statutory preconditions prescribed in the relevant Acts and Rules and hence, the said mining leases are null and void as per the Sec. 19 of the said Act. Hence, the entire 100% cost of the illegally mined and sold minerals shall be recovered as per the relevant Acts and Rules and also Supreme Court Orders.

8. The existing illegally stored above said stocks of minerals shall be seized and disposed as per the relevant Acts and Rules.

9. Moreover, the Ministry of Mines has to arrange to file proper counters to take appropriate actions against the various offenses committed by M/s. V.V. Minerals and their Associates related to the Central Acts and its Rules in the above said detailed Comprehensive Reports submitted by the Amicus Curiae on 20.06.2017 and also the Comprehensive Report dated 18.04.2018 submitted by Mr. Satyabrata Sahoo, IAS in the pending Suo Mottu on illegal mining, transport, processing, export and storage of large quantities of said minerals belong to the Government.

10. The IBM has not filed proper Counters in the above said 2 Public Interest Litigation already disposed 2 PIL Nos. on 12.12.2013 in W.P.(MD) Nos. 5549/2007, 1233/2012 and the IBM has not yet filed any Counter in the above said Suo-Motu PIL on behalf of Ministry of Mines and IBM to recover the 100% cost of the illegally mined and sold, seize the minerals in accordance with the Supreme Court Orders.

11.1. You are fully aware that our Federation have only obtained 3000 Nos. of information from the concerned Central and State Government departments and exposed the lootings by submitting the required document evidences to the said 5 Special Teams.

11.2. Some IBM Officials are preventing the filing of proper counter with an intension to suppress their omissions and commissions **which have caused the looting of over One Lakh Crores worth of minerals** and also illegal storage of **1,49,96,223 MTs** of Run of Mines, Processed and Semi Processed Garnet, Ilmenite, Rutile, Zircon, Sillimanite, Leucoxene and Monazite and also **Monazite tailings 1,35,135 MTs** in total violation of law that too, within the National Marine Park and CRZ areas.

12.1. We draw your kind attention to the Ministry of Mines letter No.9/1/2014-M.V dated 27.09.2017 in which they have requested all the State and Central Government

departments to follow the Supreme Court orders passed on 02.08.2017 in WP(Civil) No. 114/2014.

12.2. Moreover, there are some other Supreme Court Orders dated 18.03.2004 in Writ Petition (Civil) 4677/1985 (mining leases operated in violation of the mining plan condition to be cancelled), 04.09.2014 in Criminal Appeal No. 499/2011 (to take action under Sec. 378 of IPC) and dated 07.02.2018 Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No. 32138/2015 (cancellation of renewal of 88 Nos. of Iron Ore mining leases).

12.3. We also enclose herewith a chart in tabular column format under the 3 headings 1. Violation confirmed by the Supreme Court Orders in Iron and Manganese Ore mining, 2. Acts wise and Rules wise violations committed by M/s. V.V. Minerals and their Associates and 3. Actions to be taken as per the Supreme Court Orders in compliance of Articles 142.

13.1. It is the largest proven scam in India with undisputable evidences based on the 5 Special Teams submitted reports to the Government based on our said 3 PILs.

13.2. The IBM only has earlier filed counter on behalf of Ministry of Mines suppressing facts to cover up the various omissions and commissions in violations of law in the said Suo-PIL.

14. We therefore request you to kindly furnish the following information under RTI Act 2005 so as to protect the interest of the National Mineral Wealth and also prevent the further commission and omission of the violations mentioned in the above said reports.

1. Copies of the Note files showing the actions taken on the following violations committed in looting of the placer minerals, as per the already passed rulings of the Supreme Court Orders dated 04.09.2014 in Criminal Appeal No. 499/2011, 02.08.2017 in W.P.(Civil) No.114/2014 and 07.02.2018 in Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No. 32138 of 2015 for the same similar violations that were committed in looting of the iron and manganese ore by the illegal exporters in compliance of Article 142 of Constitution of India to file appropriate counters to the Hon'ble High Court to enable to pass same Rulings, as passed by the Supreme Court for the same violations, in similar looting of the said iron and manganese ores, in the pending above said Suo-Moto PIL.
- i. To cancel the illegally granted mining leases for Atomic Minerals to M/s. V.V. Minerals, M/s. Transworld Garnet India Pvt. Ltd, M/s. Beach Mineral Sand Co. M/s. Industrial Mineral India (P) Ltd, Mr. M. Ramesh and Mr. K. Thangaraj without complying the specific statutory pre-conditions of Environment Clearance prescribed in the Mining Plan approval letters by IBM and AMD as per the Environment Protection Act, 1986, Consent to Establish and Operate under Water and Air Act and other statutory preconditions prescribed in the relevant Acts and its Rules applicable for grant of the mining leases within the National Marine Biosphere (60 Nos.) and the CRZ areas (3 Nos.).
- ii. To recover the 100% cost of the illegally mined and sold atomic minerals.
- iii. To take criminal actions under Sec. 378 of Indian Penal Code as per the Supreme Court Order dated 04.09.2014 in 04.09.2014 in Criminal Appeal No. 499/2011.
- iv. To cancel the illegally transferred 21 Nos. Garnet mining leases in total violation of Rule 37 of MCR, 1960 as per the said Supreme Court Order dated 02.08.2017.

- v. Copies of the note files showing the actions taken on illegal mining, transport and storage of **1,49,96,223 MTs** of Run of Mines, Processed and Semi Processed Garnet, Ilmenite, Rutile, Zircon, Sillimanite, Leucoxene and Monazite by the first 10 entities mentioned in page No. 32 of the Comprehensive Report submitted to the High Court by Special Team Head Mr. Sathyabratta Sahoo, IAS and also **Monazite tailings 1,35,135 MTs by M/s. V. V. Minerals**
2. Copies of the following correspondences made between on our representations and also in connection with illegal mining and filing of counters in the above said Suo-Moto PIL in W.P. No. 1592/2015 from 01.01.2016 to till date to enable the Hon'ble High Court to pass appropriate orders based on your counter :
- The Ministry of Mines and the Controller General of Mines/Chief Controller of Mines, Nagpur.
 - Copies of the note file showing the action taken for approval of the mining plan with imaginary instiu and replenishable reserves, bulk density and mineralogy contrary to the ground truths.

We have enclosed herewith an Indian Postal Order bearing No. 35F 265231 dated 30.05.2018 for Rs.10/- in favour of Pay and Accounts Officer, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi towards the prescribed fee under Rule 3 of the Right to Information (Regulation of fee and cost) Rules, 2005 for the same.

Chart showing violations committed in Iron and Manganese Ore mining by the companies as per the Supreme Court orders and similar violations committed in Placer Minerals mining by M/s. V.V. Minerals and their Associates and hence, the same rulings of the Supreme Court orders passed on illegal mining of the Iron Ore and Manganese ores are also applicable for placer mineral mining as per the Article 142 of the Constitution of India.

Acts and Rules wise violations related to Iron and Manganese Ores as confirmed by SC orders on such violations committed in Placer Minerals and also Placer Minerals and their Associates and the Govt. of Jharkhand in compliance of the relevant Acts and Rules

Supreme Court Order dated 02.08.2017 in WP(Civil) No. 114 of 2014 on illegal mining of Iron and Manganese ores in Odisha.

The Para 10 of the said SC order says that out of 177 mining leases 107 lease holders did not have permits to extract mineral resources under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986

As per order of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 or approved mining plan and/or Consent to Operate order. Also provisions of this Act or any rules or (Prevention and Control of Pollution Act, 1986) or the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1987.

The Para 184 of the said SC order says that we intend to issue mineral leases only to those who have obtained mineral rights without an Act or without both could extract the provisions of Section 142 of the Constitution of India.

Confirmed Acts and Rules wise violations committed in Placer Minerals by M/s. V.V. Minerals and their Associates and the Govt. of Jharkhand

Supreme Court Order dated 02.08.2017 in WP(Civil) No. 114 of 2014 on illegal mining of Iron and Manganese ores in Odisha.

No mining lease should be granted otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of this Act and the rules made there under as per Sec.1(2) of MMDR Act, 1957.

Any mining lease granted or renewed or acquired in contravention of the provisions of this Act or any rules or orders made there under shall be void and of no effect as per sec.19 of MMDR Act, 1957.

Wherever any person takes, without any lawful authority, any mineral from any area in the State in which it may recover from such person the mineral so raised, or where such

Supreme Court Order dated 02.08.2017 in WP(Civil) No. 114 of 2014 on illegal mining of Iron and Manganese ores in Odisha.

The grant of the said 88 New leases, licenses etc. being leases by the Govt. of Jharkhand and Govt. of Odisha as per the order of the said SC is confirmed in the said Supreme Court Order.

In the said order Nos. Garnet, Bauxite etc. and other minerals which are not complying the said statutory provisions prescribed in the said Acts and Rules in compliance with article 142 of the Constitution of India

Since the entire minerals owned and sold (Garnet, Bauxite etc. covering said 68 Nos. minerals) are illegal in view of the provisions of the said Act and Rules, the cost of the illegally mined and sold minerals

exercise by the State Government or its authority authorised in this behalf by that Government or its authority. (3) The State Government or its authority authorised in this behalf by that Government or its authority may, if necessary, obtain the help of the police to effect the recovery from the land. (4) Whenever any person raises, transports or causes to be moved or transmits, without any lawful authority, any mineral from any land, and, for that purpose, uses any tool, equipment, vehicle or any other thing, such mineral tool, equipment, vehicle or any other thing shall be liable to be seized by an officer or authority specially empowered in this behalf.

(4A) Any mineral, tool, equipment, vehicle or any other thing seized under sub-section (3) shall be disposed of in accordance with the directions of the court (except in the cases specified in the offence under sub-section (1) and shall be disposed of in accordance with the directions of such court.)

(5) Whenever any person raises, without any lawful authority, any mineral from air, land, the State Government may recover from such person the mineral so raised or, where such mineral has already been disposed of, the price thereof, and may also recover from such person, tool, equipment, vehicle or any other thing, used for the period during which the land was occupied by such person without any lawful authority. (6) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), an offence under sub-section (1) shall be cognizable.

Note: The Iron and Manganese Ores mining shall be done in compliance of the following 7 Acts and its Rules:

- (1) The Mines and Minerals (BSR) Act 1957, (2) Mines and Mineral (Regulation & Development) Amendment Act 2015 (3) The Environment Clearance under Environment Protection Act, 1986.
